
MISSION

WINGS UNDERSTANDS TRAUMA AND HOW TO TREAT IT

Experiencing trauma has REAL physical and emotional impacts. WINGS staff is professionally trained to recognize and respond to all types of trauma. Once at the safe house, the survivors are physically away from the trauma. With counseling and support, they can overcome the trauma and rebuild a sense of control and empowerment. Each person is treated for their unique situation and needs so that everyone can live a life free from abuse.

WINGS Children's Program Gives Survivors A New Life Through Knowledge and Healing

The most vulnerable of the survivors are children. Once they settle into WINGS, the staff uses age appropriate therapy to talk with them about domestic violence and its effects. They help them tell their story through words, play and art therapy. WINGS counselors teach them the connections between thoughts, feelings and behaviors and how to cope with their emotions. Parents are taught how to support their children's healing. With these therapies, children blossom and start a new life with new hope.
