Dear WINGS Family,

Tonight, we celebrate the 20th Annual Purple Tie Ball. Unlike every other year, we cannot be physically together, but that does not mean that we are not connected. WINGS is a family that shares a unique bond between clients, graduates, staff, board, councils, volunteers, donors and the community. We are all here for each other through anything that life throws at us. We have all rallied around survivors of domestic violence who access WINGS to give them a hand up and out of the abuse.

Over the past six months, the increase in domestic violence has been significant. The statewide hotline experienced a 70% increase in calls. WINGS staff were there to respond. While everything shut down, WINGS Safe Houses and homes remained open even though we had to move several families into hotel rooms for their health and safety. The staff were amazing as they moved families from emergency shelter into permanent housing as if there were no pandemic at all!

During the unrest across the city of Chicago, our WINGS Metro Safe House was spared any damage and the staff kept all of the families safe inside.

In March, we were forced to shut down our four resale stores. This caused a significant loss of revenue and several staff were furloughed. In spite of this, the remaining staff capitalized on collecting donations from the community as people cleaned out closets. This ensured the stores were fully stocked when they reopened in June. The entire resale staff returned and are serving customers and donors in new, safe ways.

This pandemic has created new challenges, but with the support of thousands of donors we are surviving and thriving. WINGS is fortunate to have great leadership in our Board Co-Chairs, Rita Canning and Ellaine Sambo-Reyther. We are grateful to the leadership and support of Matt Baumann who served as our President for many years.

Each and every one of you make a difference in the lives of survivors and their children. Thank you for joining the Purple Tie Ball and thank you for all of your support!

## Silent Auction and Donation Instructions

#### Below are the three ways you can donate during the event:

**Text** "wings" to phone number 56651. Follow the prompts to make and pay for your donation.

*Link* — use https://cbo.io/d/wings to give a secure donation today. Simply enter the link in your web browser and follow the steps to make your donation. It's that easy and quick.

*Call* 847-714-1515 from 5:30pm - 7:00pm CST on Saturday, October 3 and one of our dedicated staff members will take down your information and process your donation. Be sure to have your credit card on hand.

#### Silent Auction Bidding Instructions

You can register and start bidding anytime starting now through 7:00 PM on October 3. If you're new to the world of online bidding, don't fear, we've got you covered with our 2-step process to registering, bidding, and purchasing your silent auction items.

First things first, you can use ClickBid from any desktop or laptop computer, smart phone, or tablet. It does not require you to download a new application, simply enter this URL: https://wings.cbo.io into your preferred Internet browser to access the auction. You will, however, need a data or internet connection.

#### Step 1: Register Your Account

Once you arrive on the home page for the auction (again, that URL is https://wings.cbo.io), click on the purple "Register Now" button. This will take you to a simple registration form, which requires your name, address, phone number, email address, and create a password.

It also asks if you would like to enable text alerts; activating text alerts will allow ClickBid to send you text notifications when someone outbids you on an item. Complete the registration form, then click the blue "Submit" button.

Next, you'll receive a welcome e-mail from ClickBid, which will provide important information about the event, the silent auction, and your bidder number. You will need your bidder number in order to participate in the auction. You will also receive a welcome text with the link to start bidding.

#### Step 2: You can now start browsing and bidding on items!

You can go to the blue menu button to browse by category. Click on menu and my items - to see the items you are winning, losing or marked as favorites.

# David K. Hill Award Winner

#### Jillvona "Jill"

Looking from the outside, Jill was a college student who appeared to have everything going well. In reality, she was enduring physical and emotional abuse from her boyfriend and hiding the bruises and swelling from classmates, employers, and friends. In Jill's senior year of college, she became pregnant. Knowing the difficulties single mothers face, Jill was determined to graduate. However, Jill experienced a devastating event when her college apartment was destroyed by fire, leaving her homeless and unable to stay in school. Jill stayed with those who willingly offered her a place to sleep, but often she resorted to sleeping in her car with her daughter. After a few years of being homeless, Jill connected with WINGS Program. Coming to WINGS, Jill found a safe place to heal. She had big aspirations and wanted the opportunity to afford her daughter a life free from domestic violence and homelessness.

Upon entering WINGS, it was evident that Jill was determined to become successful and independent. Jill remained employed full-time during her two years in the program, working security jobs and ultimately obtaining a job working for the U.S. Post Office. Jill worked diligently on maintaining a monthly budget, reduced her debt by 60%, and purchased a new car. Jill successfully completed WINGS Parenting and Money Management classes, and developed strong life skills that led her to receive awards during WINGS Annual Clean-a-thon.

When Jill's daughter was diagnosed with a medical emergency, she found herself having to be her daughter's strongest advocate. Working with WINGS staff, being committed to her counseling sessions, open to learning new skills, particularly parenting skills; Jill was able to approach this very difficult situation head on.

Having to leave college after the apartment fire, one of Jill's goals was to complete her Bachelor's degree. She was assigned a WINGS educational mentor, who helped Jill prepare for her final classes at Roosevelt University. Recently completing her classes, Jill is ready to graduate, after much hard work and determination!

In addition to completing college, Jill wanted to tackle her life dream to become a police officer. She completed the Hoffman Estates Community Police Academy, and is currently scheduled to graduate in November 2020 from the Police Academy in Memphis, Tennessee. Moving to Memphis was another dream of Jill's. After exiting WINGS Program, she was able to rent a house at market price and fulfill this dream too.






