- WINGS transportation team is willing to pick up the donations after your drive is complete.
- WINGS is a Nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization. We have donation receipts available.

Items needed:

- Clothing, Footwear and Outerwear (women's, children's and men's)
- Accessories, Scarves, Jewelry, Purses and Handbags
- Linens

Please Note:

- Soft donations such as clothes must be placed in sealed plastic bags or boxes.
- Clothing items are accepted for all seasons.
- We take everything regardless of condition. WINGS has staff and volunteers that sort through the clothing and unusable clothing is recycled, not thrown away. WINGS has environmentally friendly recycling arrangements to accept unusable clothing.
